

Rules of contest

LENGTH

The contest will be open from April 10th to May 8th 2016.

ADMISSIBILITY

To participate in this contest, you must be a permanent resident of Canada of at least 18 years of age on April 10th 2016. Employees, administrators, representatives and agents of the Medieval fair of montreal are exclude, as are their marketing agents, suppliers, immediate family members, spouses and all people with whom they live at home.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

To participate automatically you must obtain the official dragon medallion of the 2016 Medieval Fair of montreal which you may buy for 10\$ during the 3 days of the salon on May 6, 7 and 8 of 2016. You must then fill in the participation coupon. By buying a medallion, you obtain a ticket for the draw.

NO PURCHASE REQUIRED

To participate in the contest without buying the medallion, write us a creative 50-word letter that explains why the Medieval Fait of montreal is your favourite event. Don't forget to write down your name, complete address including postal code, phone number and area code, e-mail and age. Then sign the letter and send it to Concours "Salon de la Passion Médiévale 2016», 3117 Haig, Montréal, Québec, H1N 3E9, postmarked and no later than May 8th, or it will be declared void.

DRAW

The draw will take place on Friday May 27 2016. Three winners will be chosen through an electronic draw among all entries registered since the first day of the contest. There will be a first draw for the grand prize and two other draws for the second and third prizes.

CHANCES TO WIN

The chances your name will be selected depends on the number of registered entries since the beginning of the contest.

AWARDING PRIZES

To be declared winner, every selected participant must:

have been contacted by phone within the 20 days following the draw

answer correctly to a mathematical question without any help and within a limited time. The question will be asked on the phone or by email by a Medieval Passion Salon representative at a prearranged moment.

If one does not follow the conditions mentioned above, the selected participant will be disqualified. In such a case, the Medieval Passion Salon will arrange a new draw until a participant is selected and officially declared winner.

The winner must, within 2 to 4 weeks following the validation of his prize, go get the prize at Dracolite at 6370 St-Hubert St in Montreal.
